Principal's Report

Student Reports: Term 2 is certainly moving along, with lots of exciting things happening at Jasper Road Public school. At present, teachers are completing Semester One student reports which will come home to parents and carers on Monday 6th July. Parent-Teacher interview are also scheduled to begin later in the term. Notes for interviews have already been sent home. These offer an excellent opportunity to discuss your child's progress, so we would encourage you to make an appointment to meet with your child's teacher.

Swine Flu: The situation with the H1N1 Influenza 09 (Human Swine Flu) is continuing to evolve daily. It is due to the changing situation in Victoria that NSW Health last week announced that, children who have recently travelled to greater metropolitan Melbourne will be required to stay away from school for seven days after their return to NSW. During these seven days, the child should stay home whether or not they have flu symptoms. This is because a person infected with the flu can spread the virus a whole day before they start to feel unwell. This is the same policy that we have in place for overseas travellers returning from countries affected by human swine influenza. Your support with this health matter is greatly appreciated.

Whooping Cough: The number of suspected cases of whooping cough in the school has increased in recent

days. If your child is showing symptoms of a runny nose followed by persistent coughing that may come in bouts, we encourage you to seek medical attention. For further information contact Public Health Unit – Sydney West on (02) 9840 3603 or contact your doctor.
