Building the Education Revolution

Funding: It is with great delight that I announce that our school has received notification that we have been funded for a three million dollar building upgrade in the second round of the Federal Government's Building the Education Revolution program. Our school will receive a two-storey four classroom brick structure and a special purpose room that will allow us to have a learning space that can be utilised for varied activities including the many small group activities that occur each day at Jasper Road to meet the needs of our students. Plans are currently being submitted. It is anticipated the work will commence next term. The building will be located behind the Year 2 classrooms in line with the demountables. There will be some disruption to our school during the building process as it is impossible for the works to occur only during the holiday periods however the benefits to the school will be enormous.

Last Wednesday our students in Years 5 & 6 went on an excursion to Minnamurra Falls.
